



## **2013 Interleague - Player Information**

**All players selected in an initial training squad must read and understand the following information.**

The WRFL will field the following Junior Interleague squads in 2013.

U12 – 24 players to be selected

U13 – 24 players to be selected

U14 (2 squads) – 52 players (26 in each squad) to be selected

U15 (2 squads) – 52 players (26 in each squad) to be selected

U16 – 24 players to be selected

A number of responsibilities and expectations go with training and playing for the WRFL at Junior Interleague level. Do not attend training if you cannot commit to meeting all of the following responsibilities and expectations.

- The coaching panel of each age group will select the final squad/s based on a number of factors (e.g., training performance, form at club level, squad balance). **Selection is a competitive process and unfortunately not all players invited to train will make the final squads.** Cuts will be made at various stages of the training program, and amended training squads will be published on the WRFL website. If you do not make the final squad please respect the coaches' decision.
- **You MUST NOT invite any of your team mates or friends to interleague training. Only those players named on the WRFL website are to attend training.**
- You must be available for all matches, and plan to attend all training sessions.
- If you are part of a final squad but are not selected for one of the squad's matches (e.g., in U14 and U15 matches a maximum of 24 players from the squad of 26 are allowed to play) you are expected to assist your team by acting as a water carrier on match day.
- Please wear your club jumper at every training session. This will help the coaches identify you.
- Each player selected in a final squad will receive a WRFL hoodie, playing apparel (guernsey, shorts, socks), and a team photo. Apparel will be presented and a team photo taken once each squad is finalised.
- There is a substantial cost to run the WRFL Interleague program, and to assist in covering this cost **each player who makes a final squad will be required to pay a levy of \$121.** This is payable by direct deposit to the WRFL bank account (details will be provided to successful players once squads are finalised) or by cash or cheque at the WRFL office. No payments will be accepted at training. **All players must pay the levy before the first scheduled interleague match or risk not being selected to play.**
- The main source of communication regarding interleague will be the WRFL website so please check it regularly (e.g., before leaving for training in case of a change of location).
